

## Pastoral Council Meeting 4/5/17

Meeting starts 6:01 PM.

### Old business.

4a) Capital Campaign update: 93 contributors (pledges). Lots of one time donations. Total collected \$210,072. Collected about \$164,000 for this campaign. Deacon Dave suggested to trim down size of new building to cut down cost.

4b) Status of WCID title transfer: Water district contract has been signed. We are waiting for the Arch Diocese to give us a check.

4c) Ministry assignment: Liaison between committee and pastoral council. Nidia had ministries added to her list.

4d) By-Laws review: Review by-laws and email to Ed so he can make changes. Will review at next meeting in May. Possibly add parish statement to agenda.

### New business

We voted and Brad is calling Kelton with our decision to let the Pregnancy Center use Hilscher Hall for their classes.

6b) Feast of the Sacred Heart Parish Picnic: Knights of Columbus have agreed to cook again. Nidia volunteered to be in charge of planning and delegating. Need volunteers to build and decorate the altar. Invite all ministries to be in the procession. Mass with the Bishop will be in the park along with the picnic. Procession will be at 10, mass will be at 11, and then the picnic will be at noon.

6c) Holy Week activities: Hall will be used for breakfast, lunch and dinner. The students will be passing out flyers and surveys to houses they go and visit with. The Thursday in Holy Week they'll attend mass, and Friday they'll attend stations of the cross. Saturday they'll have a friendly competition, they'll create a flag and song for their team. Each group will show the resurrection according to their team name (Mark, John, etc..).
